
CONTROL PANEL



- 1. ON/OFF Key
- 2. Humidity setting UP/DOWN
- Purging Indicator

- (b) ON/OFF: Press the ON/OFF key to turn the unit ON or OFF.
- 2. (**A**) and (**Y**):

Press 🗪 or 🗨 key to set or adjust humidity in the range between 26% and 90%. When the ambient humidity is below 26% "CO" will be displayed (CO = continuous operation).

4. Defrost Indicator

If necessary, the unit will go into defrosting mode. If this happens, the defrost indicator light illuminates. When defrosting is finished, the unit will return to dehumidifying mode again; the light goes off.

- 5. (P) PURGE: Press the PURGE key to empty water from the pump reservoir. During normal operation the pump purges automatically when the reservoir is full. Use 'PURGE' before moving the unit to avoid water spillage. The pump will close automatically after forty seconds continuous operation.
- T TIME: Press once to show current working time. Another push will show the total working time of the appliance.

Current working time can be reset by pressing and holding the T key. However the time that has passed will be added to the total working time.

The total working time cannot be reset.

The time can be viewed even if the appliance is not connected to the mains.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

A. Operation for General Use

- Press the ON/OFF key to turn the unit on, it will get into working mode automatically.
- After using, press ON/OFF key to turn the unit off. The water pump will turn on automatically for 40 seconds to drain the rest of the water, and then turn off automatically.

Attention:

DO NOT switch the power OFF by disconnecting at the mains socket outlet.

To avoid water spillage; **DO NOT** move the dehumidifier for at least three minutes after turning the power **OFF**.


B. Key Lock Function

If the "T" and "P" keys are pressed for 2s at the same time, the operating indicator "RUN" will flash fast, and all the keys on the control panel will be locked. To unlock repeat the same procedure.

C. Pipe Function

In a very moist space, use a plastic pipe with a diameter larger than the internal diameter of pipe for BR55C/BR85C is 150/164 mm, and connect the pipe to the hood This is a faster and more effective way of dehumidifying.

Model BR55C BR85C Pipe connection 150 164




CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the Air Filter

Ensure the dehumidifier is turned OFF and the plug is removed from the power socket before maintenance is carried out.

The working performance of dehumidifier will be greatly reduced if the filters become blocked.




- 1. Remove the filter as showed in the images above.
- Vacuum any debris from the filter using the vacuum hose and nozzle attachment.
- 3. Use lukewarm water and a mild detergent to wash the filter and allow to dry.
- 4. Once dry, re-install filter into the dehumidifier.

Checking the Drain Hose

• Unplug the drain hose and check that there are no obstructions. If so, replace the hose to avoid water spills.

DRAINAGE

- The dehumidifier pump connects to plastic drainage hose. The hose is stored on the back of the appliance. Uncoil the entire hose ensuring there are no kinks or restrictions and place the unattached end into a water vessel or run to outdoors.
- Ensure that water which runs to outdoors does NOT create a slip hazard.
- Water vessels MUST be checked regularly where used.
- The position of the drain water pipe must not be too high (<4.5 metres). Failure to do so may cause a water backup in the pump, resulting in leakage.




SETTING UP INSTRUCTIONS

/ IMPORTANT

Place the dehumidifier in upright position. When transporting a dehumidifier to site, allow the dehumidifier to stand for 30 minutes before switching ON. This is necessary to allow the refrigerant system to stabilise and avoid system damage.


Operate the dehumidifier in an enclosed area, as this creates a drying chamber. Close all doors, windows or areas that open to external areas, to maximize the dehumidifier's water removal efficiency. Keep traffic through the drying chamber to a minimum. Place the dehumidifier in the centre of the room, away from walls and furnishings. DO NOT allow the airflows to be obstructed.

Replacing the Battery

- 1. Remove the screws in the four corners of the control panel.
- 2. Once the screws are removed, carefully lift the control panel to access the PCB.
- 3. On the PCB is a 9V 6F22 battery. Remove the battery and replace with new.
- 4. Refit the control panel onto the PCB.
- Refit the four screws.



TROUBLE SHOOTING




